4. How Will We Succeed?

- iii. Participate in personal and communal faith formation activities

c. The Parish Team

- Works with the Faith in Action Team and the staff FIAT leaders to support their ministry.
- ii. Provides opportunities for faith formation
- iii. Provides resources for FIAT where possible.
- iv. Informing and encouraging parish support of the FIAT activities.
- v. Provide financial support







d. The FIAT Coordinators



- i. Coordinate, support and provide resources all the Faith In Action Teams
- ii. Maintain FIAT website & social media
- iii. Facilitate communications with all FIAT partners (schools, parishes, diocese & school board)
- iv. Order FIAT t-shirts
- v. Assemble, maintain & replenish FIAT prayer kits
- vi. Organize annual FIATFEST celebration
- vii. To seek financial partners to support the ministry
- viii. Continue to develop future growth of the FIAT ministry
